**Hula**

Hula class will include basic hand, foot, and body movements that gracefully entwine to tell the stories of Hawaii's history, places, people and traditions...all infused with the spirit of Aloha. The class will also incorporate simple Hawaiian phrases, Hawaiian traditions, and a simple choreography. Hula, Hawaii's joyous cultural dance, is suitable for both boys and girls. For many centuries women did not perform the Hula; it was performed only by men!!!

**Ukulele**

Ukulele is a fun gateway to stringed instruments and self-accompaniment. This class will introduce the parts of the instrument, picking, strumming, and chord changes while singing classic songs.

**Puppet Making:** Be creative and learn to make puppets!

**Hip Hop Dance:** Learn the moves and skills to use dancing Hip Hop. Appropriate music will be used.
